**Delaware State Report**

DE ASFAA committee members for 2005-06 are Debra McCain, Delaware Technical & Community College, Wilmington Campus; Jennifer Grunden, Delaware Technical & Community College, Terry Campus; Veronica Oney, Delaware Technical & Community College, Owens Campus.

Projects in process:

- Financial Aid Nights, 2005-06: contact has been made with each of the high school counselors who hosted these programs last year. Letters and flyers will be updated, mailed to each Delaware high school and distributed at each of the three College Night Programs scheduled for the last week in December. In addition, a College Goal Sunday 2006 flyer will be included in the mailing for counselors to begin promoting the program and the flyers will be distributed at the College Night Programs as well. It was proposed by the membership last year that we consider a team approach to the presentations, the “buddy system”, so that the presentation duties can be a shared responsibility. We will be asking for presenters and confirming their assignments in the very near future.
- College Goal Sunday 2006: Delaware will have three sites, all hosted by Delaware Technical & Community College. There will be a site in each of Delaware’s three counties: the Stanton Campus in New Castle County, the Terry Campus in Kent County and the Owens Campus in Sussex County. Debra, Jennifer and Veronica have graciously offered their time, expertise and support for this program and will be site coordinators. They are also providing their input for advertising/marketing in their respective counties so that we can more successfully reach our target population. In my role as Delaware President, I was assured that we will have enough volunteers at each site to ensure a successful program.

Volunteers: we will be asking the membership to support the above programs to the extent that they are able. It is my hope that we will have several new volunteers with us this year, particularly for College Goal Sunday since we have increased from one to three sites.

Leadership: we must look to the membership to solicit recommendations and nominations for the next President and perhaps other leadership roles within Tristate. We have many new professionals among us, and I am hopeful that we will have some individuals who will be interested in becoming Delaware President, specifically, as my term will end this year.
